Remote work isn't new but is a growing norm.

25-30%

of the workforce

is estimated to be working at home on a multiple-days-a-week basis by the end of 2021.¹

44%

of employees

report that don't have the right technology and tools to work productively outside of the office.

believe their employers are now more open to remote work.



The employee experience has dramatically shifted.

47%

prefer working

at the office as before, once restrictions lift, while **53%** want to work from home as much as possible.²

feel they aren't

Flexibility is key.

76%

of global office workers

and **82%** of U.S. office workers say they want to continue to work from home, at least weekly.³

Only 16% of global office workers—

and **19%** in the U.S.—want to solely work from home.

Most prefer a hybrid.³

60%

of employees

would give up their desk at the office in exchange for working from home some or all of the time.⁴

Security investments are non-negotiable.

With 70%

of organizations planning to

increase cybersecurity spending following the current crisis, protection must extend beyond the network to employee devices.⁵

Barracuda Networks reported a **667% upsurge in phishing**

emails since the end of February.

Since COVID-19,

the FBI has seen a 300% increase in cybercrime. Companies need to invest more in security to protect dispersed workforce.
